Hence to promote the cause of sports, in addition to nurturing the talent of acclaimed sportswomen, the department strives to reach out to each member of the Miranda community, through specially designed activities and events for the teachers and students.

With the beginning of the session, the tussle of performing the best started within the teams. The year started in the lush green monsoon-perched fields of Miranda House with all teams participating hard. The session began with Fresher's Cross Country race on 14th August 2015, witnessing mass participation by 1st year students with enthusiasm and zeal towards fitness and sports. This was followed by beginning of Aerobic, Taekwondo and Yoga classes. A certificate course in Foundation of Yogasana for beginners was organized in the month of September. Organizing a Cricket match for the non-teaching staff members is one of the annual features of the Department to promote health and sportsmanship among the Miranda House community. This year it was organized on 6th February 2016.

EROBERN, the Annual Sports Fest of Miranda House, was successfully organized for the fourth consecutive year from 10th to 12th February 2016. This year it was bigger and better as Basketball and Sports Quiz were included among the official events along with Ball Badminton, Chess, Netball and Taekwondo. Vibrant participation of sports teams across the university in all the six events had made it a grand success. The Department has also organized Shot Put event for the teaching staff and fun activities for Differently Abled students.

Miranda House sportswomen continued to excel in almost all disciplines of sports. Our player's performance were outstanding this year at International, National, All India/ North Zone Inter University, Inter College and other State level tournaments in Athletics, Archery, Ball Badminton, Basketball, Chess, Netball, Power Lifting/ Weight Lifting, Tennis, Soft Tennis, Taekwondo, Volleyball and Yoga.

The Taekwondo Team won 4 Gold Medals in the Delhi State Taekwondo Championship; 3 Gold, 2 Silver and 2 Bronze Medals in the 4th Ch. Ran Singh Memorial Taekwondo Grand Prix Championship and Winners Trophy in the Bharti Cup Taekwondo Championship with 5 Gold, 1 Silver and 2 Bronze Medals. Kanchan Pandey (B. Sc. (H) Physics) had won II place in the Uttrakhand State Rifle Shooting Competition.
