Annual Report 2017-18 Department of Physical Education and Sports Sciences

The broad objective of NSO programme is to raise the college or university sports standards in general along with achievements of excellence in sports performance by the talented students in particular. To achieve these objectives coaching camps are organized and financial assistance is also given in some of the cases. In line with the objectives of NSO programmes, to promote the cause of sports, in addition to nurturing the talent of acclaimed sportswomen, the Department of Physical Education and Sports strives to reach out to each member of the Miranda community, through specially designed activities and events for the teachers and students.

With the beginning of the session, the tussle of performing the best started within the teams. The year started in the lush green monsoon-perched fields of Miranda House with all teams participating hard. The session began with Fresher's Cross Country race on 11th August 2017, witnessing mass participation by 1st year students with enthusiasm and zeal towards fitness and sports. This was followed by beginning of Yoga and Taekwondo classes.

Erobern, the Annual Sports Fest of Miranda House, was successfully organized for the sixth consecutive year from 7th to 9th February 2018. Total five sports viz. Ball Badminton, Chess, Rhythmic Yoga, Taekwondo and Tennis were organized. Vibrant participation of sports teams across the university in all the five events had made it a grand success. Events for the general students and especially abled students of Miranda house were also organized. Total six events such as lemon and spoon race, shot put and discus throw were organized for the students.

The department also organized athletic meet for the non teaching staff of the college on 19th and 20th March 2018. The competitors competed in various track and field events viz. 60 mts. Race (for male), lemon and spoon race (for female) and shot put (for male and female). The event witnessed enthusiastic mass participation from the staff.

Miranda House sportswomen continued to excel in almost all disciplines of sports. Our player's performance were outstanding this year at International, National, All India/ North Zone Inter University, Inter College and other State level tournaments in Athletics, Archery, Ball Badminton, Basketball, Chess, Netball, Shooting, Table Tennis, Tennis, Taekwondo and Yoga. Our students remained on the winning spree also in the open tournaments and college invitational tournaments organized. The Chess team won Silver medal in SRCC sports fest and Gold medal in Erobern sports fest of Miranda House; Rhythmic yoga team won gold in in Erobern sports fest of Miranda House and sports fest of Shaheed Rajguru College of Applied Sciences, Ball Badminton team won bronze medal in sports fest of SRCC and Erobern Miranda House. Taekwondo team won the championship in Erobern by winning 04 gold and 03 silver medal. In tennis we won one silver in Invitational Tennis Tournament organized by Indraprastha College for Women and along with that one sliver and one bronze at Erobern 2018. In Delhi State Taekwondo Championships -2017 Iftesam Khan, Vibhuti and Deepika Seharawat won gold medals;, and in Delhi State Yoga Championship Rohini won bronze and Taranpreet ranked fifth.
