North East Regional Research and Resource Centre, Miranda House

Overview

North East Regional Research and Resource Centre (NERRRC), is an undergraduate Research Centre at Miranda House, that has been established with funding from the North Eastern Council Shillong, Government of India. It is the first of its kind UG multidisciplinary Research Centre within Delhi University College. The primary objective is to cultivate research, innovation, and entrepreneurial endeavours, particularly among young women. NERRRC acts as a dedicated research and resource hub focusing on women-centric research, innovation, and entrepreneurship in the North Eastern Region (NER) at Miranda House. The initiative aims to foster closer connections and understanding among students, recognising the youth as pivotal ambassadors. Through active engagement, knowledge sharing, and practical research methodologies, NERRRC endeavours to bridge gaps and promote collaboration, envisioning a vibrant platform for learning and growth.

Activities






1. Skill Enhancement Programmes

The Centre organises a series of skill enhancement programmes for the students as following:

1. Workshop on CV and S.O.P. Writing

On the 25th of April 2022, the North East Regional Research and Resource Centre, Miranda House, organised a three-day CV and SOP writing workshop at the Seminar Hall of Miranda House. The workshop had 60 participants in groups of 20. The workshop was focused on providing participants with guidance on how to write effective CVs and SOPs, highlighting common mistakes, and including interactive sessions for practical learning.

2. Research Methodologies Workshop

The North East Regional Research and Resource Centre recently organised a Research Methodologies workshop from 12-14 May 2022. The workshop took place in Room No. 145, Miranda House, with 30 participants. The aim of the workshop

was to provide participants with a comprehensive understanding of qualitative and quantitative research techniques, writing practices, and common mistakes that need to be avoided while conducting research.

3. Workshop on Research Methodologies - Introduction to Geographical Information Systems

The North East Regional Research and Resource Centre organised a two-day Introduction to Geographical Information Systems (GIS) workshop on June 21-23, 2022, at Room No. 145, Miranda House. The workshop was aimed at introducing the participants to GIS, its components, applications, and importance in research. This was the Second part of workshop on research methodologies.

4. Workshop on Research Methodologies - E-Learning and Digital Tools for Students

On the 18th to 20th of July 2022, a workshop on e-learning and digital tools for students was conducted by North East Regional Research and Resource Centre, Miranda House. This was the third part of workshop on research methodologies. The aim of the workshop was to help participants understand the new digital platforms and how they can be used to improve students' marketability and skills. The workshop was held at Room No. 145, Miranda House and was attended by 30 participants from various disciplines.

5. Workshop on Research Methodologies - Introduction to SPSS

The workshop on "Introduction to SPSS" was organised by the North East Regional Research and Resource Centre (NERRRC) at Miranda House from August 17 to 19, 2022. The workshop was held in Room No. 145 at Miranda House, with a duration of six hours each day, from 10.00 A.M. to 5.00 P.M. This was the fourth part of workshop on research methodologies. There was a total of 25 participants – who were students in various departments of Miranda House College.

6. Certificate Course on Radio Broadcasting

The Radio Broadcasting Course was conducted by NERRRC from 20 March 2023 to 25 March 2023. The 30-hour course was designed to provide students with a comprehensive understanding of radio production and presentation, with a focus on hands-on training in a practical environment. A total of 30 students enrolled



in the course, with 25 students successfully completing the course. The participants were from diverse academic backgrounds and had a keen interest in radio broadcasting.

2. Conferences and Ideation Sessions

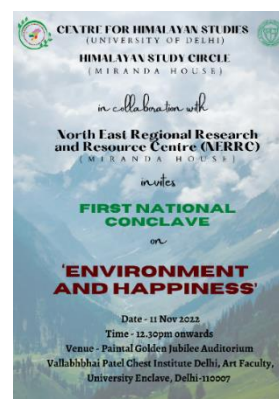
1. Ideation Conclave 1

4. International Conference Start-Ups, Sustainability, Innovation, and Entrepreneurship in North-Eastern India.

On 28th March 2023; the Northeast Regional, Research, and Resource Centre (NERRRC) organized the first of a two-day International Conference on Start-Ups, Sustainability, Innovation, and Entrepreneurship in North-Eastern India.
