**Ved Jolly Resilience Awards for Motivated Scholars 2018-19**  
**B.Sc. (Honours) I, II and III Year Students**

**About**

- These awards were instituted in the Academic Year 2017-18 by the Principal, Dr. Pratibha Jolly, in memory of her mother Ved Jolly.
- There are three awards, one each, for students of I, II and III year, selected from those pursuing any of the B.Sc. (H) courses in Botany, Chemistry, Mathematics, Physics, and Zoology.
- The three merit-cum-need awards are of Rs. 15,000, each.

**Eligibility Criteria**

- Financial Status
- Good Academic record in each semester
- Cumulative Semester Grade Point Average (SGPA) of previous semesters with no academic backlog
- Cumulative Attendance Record with at least 75% attendance in each semester
- Vibrant participation in co-curricular/extracurricular activities

**Application**

- Applications in requisite format should be duly verified and forwarded by the teacher-in-charge of the parent department before being submitted to the Scholarship Desk, Accounts Section.

**Important Dates**

- Students of I Year will be required to apply in Semester II by January 31 on the basis of Semester I results.
- **Students of II and III Year will be required to apply in Odd Semester by 14 August on the basis of cumulative performance in previous semesters.**

**Selection**

- The awardees will be chosen by a duly constituted Selection Committee consisting of the Principal, Vice Principal, Bursar, two teacher representatives on Governing Body; and senior most amongst the teachers-in charge of science departments.
- In subsequent years, preference will be given to the student who was given this award in the earlier year so that she is supported for all three years of study.

**Award**

- The student awardee of I Year will receive the award amount by 7 March.
- **The student awardees of II and III Year will receive the award amount by 31 August.**
- All student awardees will be given the *Ved Jolly Resilience Award for Motivated Scholar* Certificate on the Founder's Day of the college, celebrated on 7 March.

Applications duly filled and verified by the Teacher-in-Charge of the parent department should be submitted to the Scholarship Desk, Accounts Branch, by the due date.
