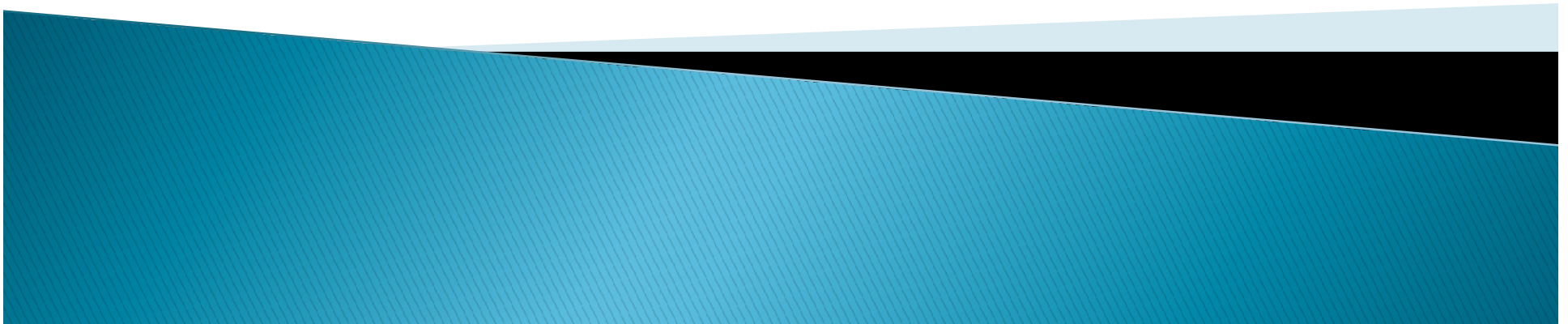

Family and Intimacy: Critiques and Transformations



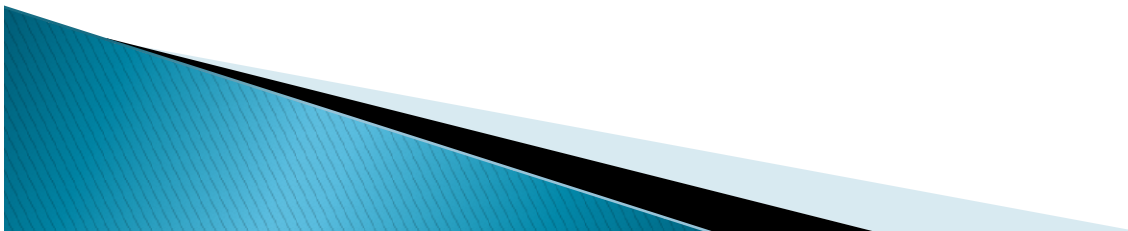

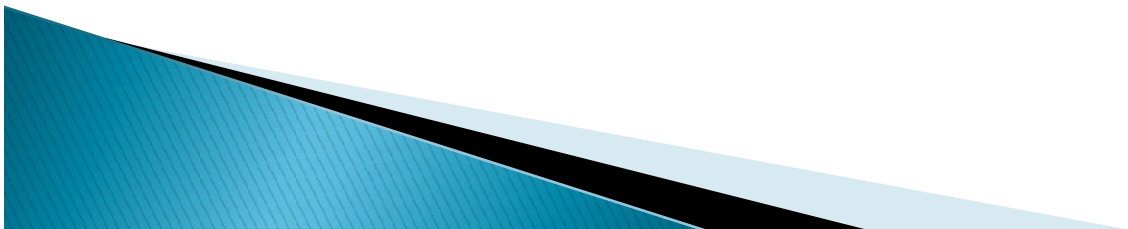
