An internal meeting of IQAC was held in the Committee Room on Thursday 1 February 2018 at 3pm.

Principal informed that

- Rs 1 lakh has been transferred from the UGC funds to IQAC for the expenses under this head;
- room number 233 (opposite Accounts Section) has been designated as the IQAC Office; this room will be fitted with computers and an Evota screen;
- Government Electronic market (GEM) is being used to procure items for the College;
- forms for streamlining Leave Application, Leave Travel Concession, Medical Reimbursement, Nomination, Festival Advance, Family Declaration have been uploaded on the College website;
- most notices are uploaded on the College website so that they are available for viewing by the entire College community;
- digital notice boards have been placed in various parts of the College to display details of up-coming events/lectures/conferences/workshops;
- a pre-project submission form/sanctioned project details/expression of interest to supervise M.Phil/PhD students has been designed;
- the Nodal Officers for AISHE are now Ms Anuradha Khattar and Dr Ritu Gupta;
- a data base of visitors to the college and resource persons already exists and is constantly being updated;
- Department of Zoology recently held a seven-day Faculty Development Program;
- Departments of Botany and Zoology have organized a Workshop for Laboratory Staff of Botany, Chemistry and Zoology Departments;
- Workshops to enhance the Computer Literacy and Financial Literacy will be held soon;
- in collaboration with Pearson, an effort is being made to record lectures and hence create a digital resource;
- Teachers-in-Charge will submit a calendar of events for their Departments so as to ensure effective use of the available spaces in the College;
- College is trying to increase the bursaries for students.

Principal suggested that Department Colloquia could be organized in the recently refurbished Heritage Hall. It was also suggested that Department Festivals be academic and as far as possible College events should be held so that there is minimum disruption of classes.

In the context of the Annual Quality Assurance report (AQAR) and the IQAC Newsletter it was decided to request:

- Teachers-in-Charge to send a brief write-up on the various events, which have enhanced the teaching-learning process, held in their Department between 1 January 2017 and 31 January 2018;
- Coordinators of various Contemporary Value Added Courses and remedial/bridge courses for their reports;
