1. Academic

- The Sanskrit department conducted a 10 day (20.06.22-02.07.22) sambhashan varg in collaboration with Samskrit Bharti to nourish the Sanskrit speaking skills of our students, where young scholars from across the disciplines participated. The programme's closing ceremony was held on 04.07.22, where all the participants were felicitated.
