27th September – Screening of Movie ‘Hey Ram’

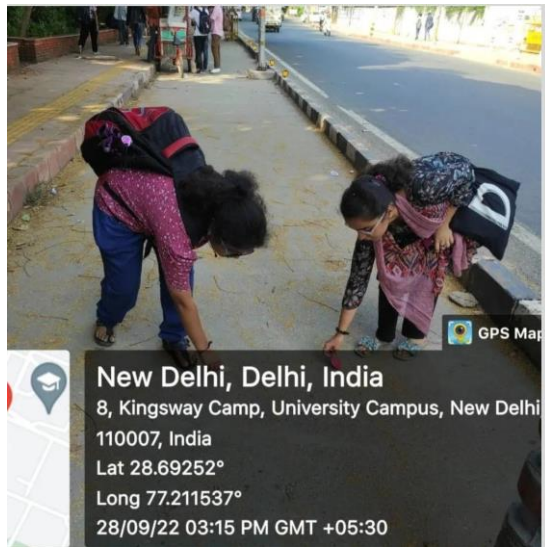
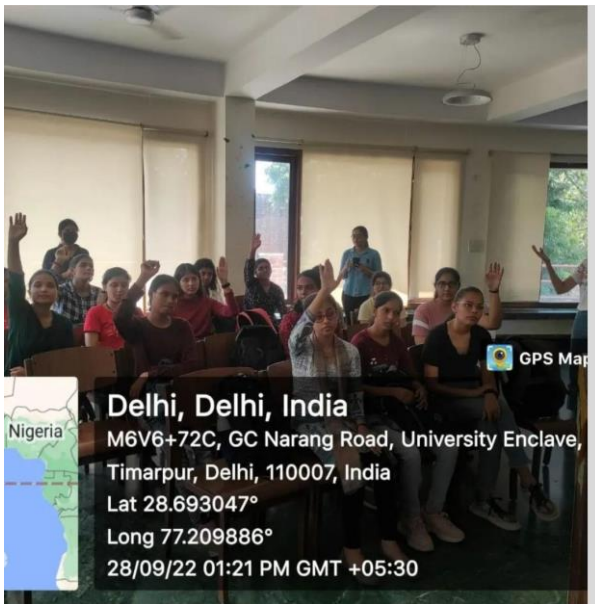
All the GSC members attended the screening of this Kamal Hasan directorial and later shared their opinions in light of the issues stressed upon in the movie.

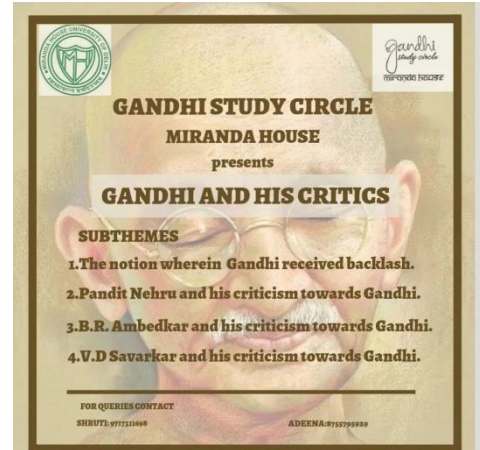


2nd October – Visit to National Gandhi Museum

Theme – ‘Mahatma Gandhi and his critics’

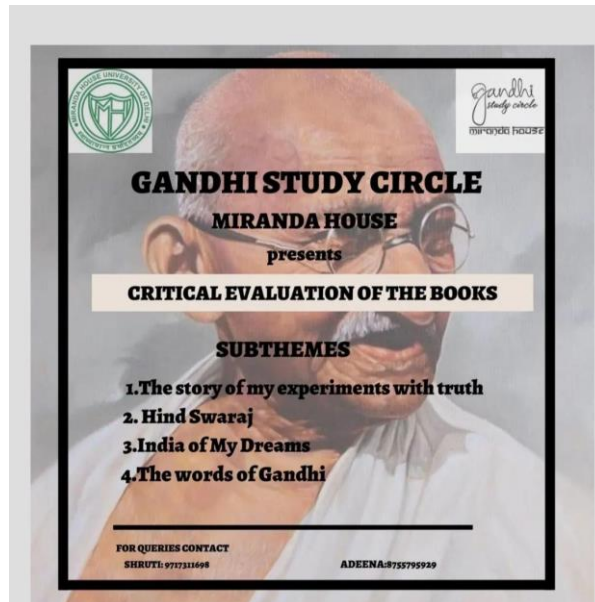
