Report of the Internal Complaint Committee 2018-19

A meeting on an emergent basis was convened by the Vice Principal Dr. Bijayalaxmi Nanda in the Office on 29th October 2018 to discuss issues emerging from the current procedure for the elections for the student's representation in the ICC. A follow-up meeting was held on 14th Dec 2018.

An Outreach Programme on Women's Safety was held on 28 August 2019. This was organized by the North-East Society of Miranda House and the Internal Complaints Committee. Speakers from National Commission for Women (NCW) were invited to address the students.

The election for the student members was held on 4 October 2019.

A series of training programs in collaboration with Delhi Police and North District Women helpline numbers were held on 19-23 November 2018.

Training workshops were held separately for Students, teaching and Non Teaching staff members at different times of the academic year.

Two complaints have been filed before ICC in 2019-20. Resolutions were provided to all the complainants. ICC provided recommendations to resolve the issues. The college took action as per the recommendations in each case.

The presiding officer of ICC, Dr. Sudeshna Bhaatatachaya has participated in one day Workshop on IMPLEMENTATION OF THE U.G.C. (PREVENTION PROHIBITION AND REDRESSAL of Sexual Harassment of Women Employees and Students in Higher Education Institutions) Regulations, 2015 organised by ICC University of Delhi. The Program was held on 12 March 2019.

Student elections to the committee were held on the 14th of March 2019.
