**Ved Jolly Resilience Award for Motivated Scholars 2023-2024**

The *Ved Jolly Resilience Awards for Motivated Scholars* was instituted by the former Principal Dr. Pratibha Jolly, in memory of her mother. The terms of reference for the three awards are as follows.

- 1. This will be merit-cum-need award of Rs. 15,000 each.**
2. There will be one award each for I Year, II Year and III Year students selected from amongst science Honours Courses, namely, B.Sc. Honours in Botany, Chemistry, Mathematics, Physics, and Zoology.
3. To be eligible, students should have at least 75% attendance, vibrant participation in co-curricular/extracurricular activities and a good academic record in each semester.
- 4. Students of II and III year may apply on the basis their cumulative performance in previous semesters. II semester may apply on the basis of their Semester I result.**
5. Applications in requisite format will have to be duly forwarded by the Teacher-in-Charge of the department.
6. The awardees will be chosen by a duly constituted Selection Committee consisting of the Principal, Vice Principal, Bursar, two teacher representatives on Governing Body; and senior most amongst the Teachers-in-Charge of the concerned science departments.
7. In subsequent years, preference will be given to the student who was given this award in the earlier year so that she is supported for all three years of study.
8. The student awardees will be given the *Ved Jolly Resilience Award for Motivated Scholar Certificate* on the Founder's Day of the college, usually celebrated on 07 March.
