Action Taken Report Students' Perception Study

A detailed Students' Perception study was conducted on the teaching-learning, infrastructure, counselling, and overall experience for the above period. The results discussed in the Academic Committee meeting were critical in identifying areas for overall improvement. A SWOT analysis for each department was conducted, focusing on strengths and opportunities while addressing challenges.

The feedback revealed positive responses in areas such as curriculum content, teacher preparedness, and inclusivity. Nearly 75% of the respondents ranked highly on their overall experience in college. Internal assessments and the mentor-mentee program were deemed effective by most students. However, areas such as awareness of grievance redressal mechanisms, access to counselling, and washroom infrastructure require attention.

TICs of respective departments held meetings with faculty to discuss these findings and identify actionable steps. Faculty members were tasked with implementing strategies to strengthen student progression, improve inclusivity, and enhance infrastructure.

Targeted actions include campaigns to raise awareness about counselling services, economic aid, and grievance redressal mechanisms, alongside efforts to upgrade facilities like washrooms and gym access. These measures align with the College's commitment to ensuring holistic development and a positive learning environment for students.

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
