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Action Taken Report Students' Perception Study

The Students' Perception study was done on a wide range of parameters ranging from teaching-learning process to guidance and counselling. Students are highly satisfied with the teaching standards, curriculum, assessment and democratic processes in the college. Nearly 75% of the respondents ranked highly on their overall experience in college. Internal assessments and the mentoring program were deemed effective by most students. However, areas such as awareness of access to career guidance and counselling require enhanced support. The administration has reviewed the student feedback and intends to provide solutions to mitigate the challenges. All the departments were advised to strengthen their documentation processes pertaining to student progression, student support through financial schemes and improve alumnae interaction.

Targeted actions include campaigns were carried to raise awareness about counselling services, scholarship, fee waiver and economic aid, and grievance redressal mechanisms. The administration is working towards upgrading facilities such as Smart Classrooms, air conditioning and better laboratories. These measures align with the College's commitment to ensuring holistic development and a positive learning environment for students.
